Introduction

The Letter to the Hebrews was written to an unspecified audience, other than they are "Hebrews." Reading between the lines, it seems they were Jews who had come to faith in Jesus as their Messiah, but they were facing some degree of persecution, and were possibly considering a return to the "old ways" of Judaism, because that might bring less trouble.

Hebrews is a work of persuasion. It builds an argument to establish that Christianity is better because Christ is superior. Block by block and point by point an overwhelming case is made for the Hebrews to press on in Christian faith, because to back off or step away makes no sense.
